This course will prepare experienced clinicians to develop skills in having conversations which allow patients to explore their wishes around Advance Care Planning. Participants will also be able to become independent signatories for DNACPR forms.

This course is open to any health care professional who is employed within primary care. Each HCP must be supported by their employing GP practice who are asked to verify that the practitioner has the level of clinical knowledge to assess patient medical history and prognostic information.

This training is supported by a competency framework which must be completed to become an independent DNACPR signatory.

This course is run as part of the CCG funded project: Enhancing identification of people likely to be in their last year of life leading to personalised care and support planning.
