Who is eligible to undertake this course?

To become a FCP/AP Roadmap Supervisor you **must** meet the following criteria:

- Be a registered Healthcare Professional who is Advanced Practitioner, a Consultant Practitioner (and hold a relevant MSc) or a GP. (GP Trainers who are also Educational Supervisors will soon be able to access a shortened version of this course via the e-Learning for Healthcare website and this will be advertised when this is available)
- Recently completed Equality and Diversity Training.

It is recommended that you commit to supervise a minimum of 1 trainee FCP/AP in the first 6 months after completing this course to consolidate the training received.

Cohort 8 – Friday 11th March & Tuesday 22nd March

Places will be initially offered on a first come first served basis to those who work in the Thames Valley and Wessex region.
